

Challenge

As chair of radiology for Fletcher Allen Health Care at Vermont's University Medical Center, Dr. Steven Braff knew the type of technology that was needed to make a significant difference in improving clinical decision making. He wanted his staff to be able to access clinical data while looking at images on McKesson's Horizon Medical Imaging picture archiving and communication system (PACS). And since the clinical data was in the hospital's Epic EMR system, the challenge was to integrate the capabilities of both systems in the most cost-efficient way possible.

Solution
